



Audio Visual (AV) - Sound

Purpose: To contribute to an environment conducive to praising and worshipping God. Using your sound mixing skills to make sure that all members of the band can hear what they need to, can be heard in the “house” mix and the overall volume is appropriate.

Time Commitment: Sundays 10:00-12:30 and practise usually Thursdays 7:30-9:00

Key Responsibilities:

- To learn and understand the fundamentals of the mixing desk and related devices.
- To learn and understand the cabling, stage connections and computer link.
- To aid in setting up the equipment on stage and packing equipment away securely.
- Keep the stage as clear as possible, removed unused kit and close the curtains.
- To liaise politely with the band members to make sure the monitor mix is right for them but also balanced with the overall sound for the congregation.
- Being attentive and sensitive to the environment and congregation and using your skills to adjust appropriately. For example, should the piano or the guitar be emphasised for the current song?
- To monitor the mix for Zoom and adjust volumes levels as necessary.
