



Fusion Team

Purpose: To provides an opportunity within the Sunday service for children to have fun, take part in a wide range of activities, and to build relationships with each other and with the team. This supports parents/carers in their own worship, and in helping families to engage with church together.

Reports to: Dave Poulson (Young People's Lead)

Time Commitment: Sundays 10am till finish

Key Responsibilities:

- Helping set up the Karis Hall before the children arrive, & praying together as a team
- Engaging with the children through specific activities (crafts, games, conversation spaces) as directed by the team leader.
- Ensuring the wellbeing of all children, maintaining appropriate adult-to-child ratios.
- Setting a good example: being positive, enthusiastic and constructive.
- Reporting any safeguarding concerns promptly to the team leader and Safeguarding team
- Engaging with parents/carers as they collect their children – acting as a communication bridge between Fusion and the family.
- Helping to pack down the Karis Hall at the end of the session.

Success Looks Like:

- Children enjoy their time, feel safe, and eagerly return each week
- Children have age-appropriate opportunities to encounter God
- Positive relationships develop between children and with the team members
