



SCALEXTRIC TEAM

Purpose: To engage a wide range of young people and their families. For some, Scalextric nights are their primary point of contact with the church, and this event can serve as a bridge into further engagement with the CCC community.

Reports to: Mark Martin (team leader); Dave Poulson (responsible for young people)

Time Commitment: Events take place every other month during the autumn and winter. An evening runs from 5.30-9pm; set-up takes place from mid-afternoon.

Key Responsibilities:

- Helping to set the church space – clearing away chairs, putting up tables for the track, laying out the track, loading the race software, turning on the PA system.
- Leading various aspects of the event: administering the races; announcing racers and results; resetting the track after each race; maintaining cars during the event.
- Engaging with the young people and adults who attend.
- Setting a good example: being positive, enthusiastic and constructive at all times.
- Reporting any safeguarding concerns promptly to the team leader and Safeguarding team.
- Helping to pack down the church space at the end of the session.

Success Looks Like:

- Everyone enjoys their time, feels safe, and returns for subsequent events.
- Young people and adults engage with the wider life of the church, and are encouraged to join other groups within the CCC community.
- Positive relationships develop between young people, between adults, and with the team members.
